b. Lot 1, Block 1 dumping site

- Meeting with the AG
- Active movement in the judicial sense
- Need to think about messaging
- A lot of information going through the process privately; want new news by the end of the year
- Question: any policy movement on categorizing illegal dumping?
 1. Treat soil differently?
 2. Case by case scheme right now. Not just in Camden but other places throughout the state... realizing amount of similar soil situations happening throughout the state
 3. EJ director and Olivia Glenn will be looped in so that it's not just the legal team... need to do more

c. Camera Systems (GovDesigns + Gridless)

- Trailer systems are expensive
- Large scale interventions don't mean that dumping isn't happening elsewhere
- Trail cameras could be an affordable option moving forwards

a. Current Issues:

- Plastics Ban
 1. Mobile food unit: farmers market gives out re-usable bags
 2. Cousin's could do a giveaway
 3. Schools
 4. DPW purchases recycling bins.. maybe they can put that funding towards reusable bags
 5. Philadelphia has a concise and clear page for messaging about the ban: <https://www.phila.gov/programs/plastic-bag-ban/>
 - a. NJ Business council -> promote their website
 6. Restaurants in Camden with Uber/ Door Dash/ Grubhub target deliveries to Camden
 7. Ask Camden county

b. Key Next Steps

- Follow Philadelphia's venture with their plastics ban (especially look into how Bodegas and similar establishments are getting support if at all)

- Follow up with NJ Business Council about their capacity to support giveaways
- Look into capacity of Cousin's, schools, DPW, the county, and restaurants to giveaway re-usable bags

 3. Partnering with CCMUA to send it out with water bills could be an option
 4. Powercorp could distribute resources
 5. Billboard outside of city hall can use to spread the word about waste collection
 - a. North Camden and east Camden billboards also
